WCC website is up and running as a part of Town website (Town Departments, Conservation Commission - <http://www.westfordvt.us/conservation.php>).

The Fall/Winter edition of the Westford Community Business and Farmers' Market Brochure is out. Copies will be available at the Town Library, Town Office, and Westford Market. The brochure is published 2x/yr - Spring/Summer, Fall/Winter.

WCC is working to prepare its annual report (due mid-January).

As reported last month, details of the "adopt a trail" program have been updated. Current adopters of Schultz, Seymour, Goodrich, Covey, and Rogers trails will be asked to confirm their willingness to continue in this role and given updated program details. As a thank you for their service, adopters will be given a WCC T-shirt and a thank you will be published in the Town newsletter (note: year end newsletter will also note that donations can be made to the WCC).

As reported last month, information on the Schultz trail has been provided to LocoMotion for their website. A WCC member will have a password to manage this info, but this password has not yet been made available.

Additional items relate to Westford's public trails:

- 1) mapping school trails so they show greater detail than current trail map,
- 2) investigating whether there is any possible Westford route to connect to Hanley Lane in Essex,
- 3) WCC recommendations to Selectboard regards trail use.

WCC is reviewing details for a VT state grant application regards water quality projects.
