
















Map 3 Natural Features Westford Vermont

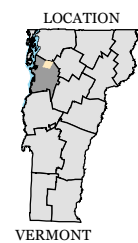
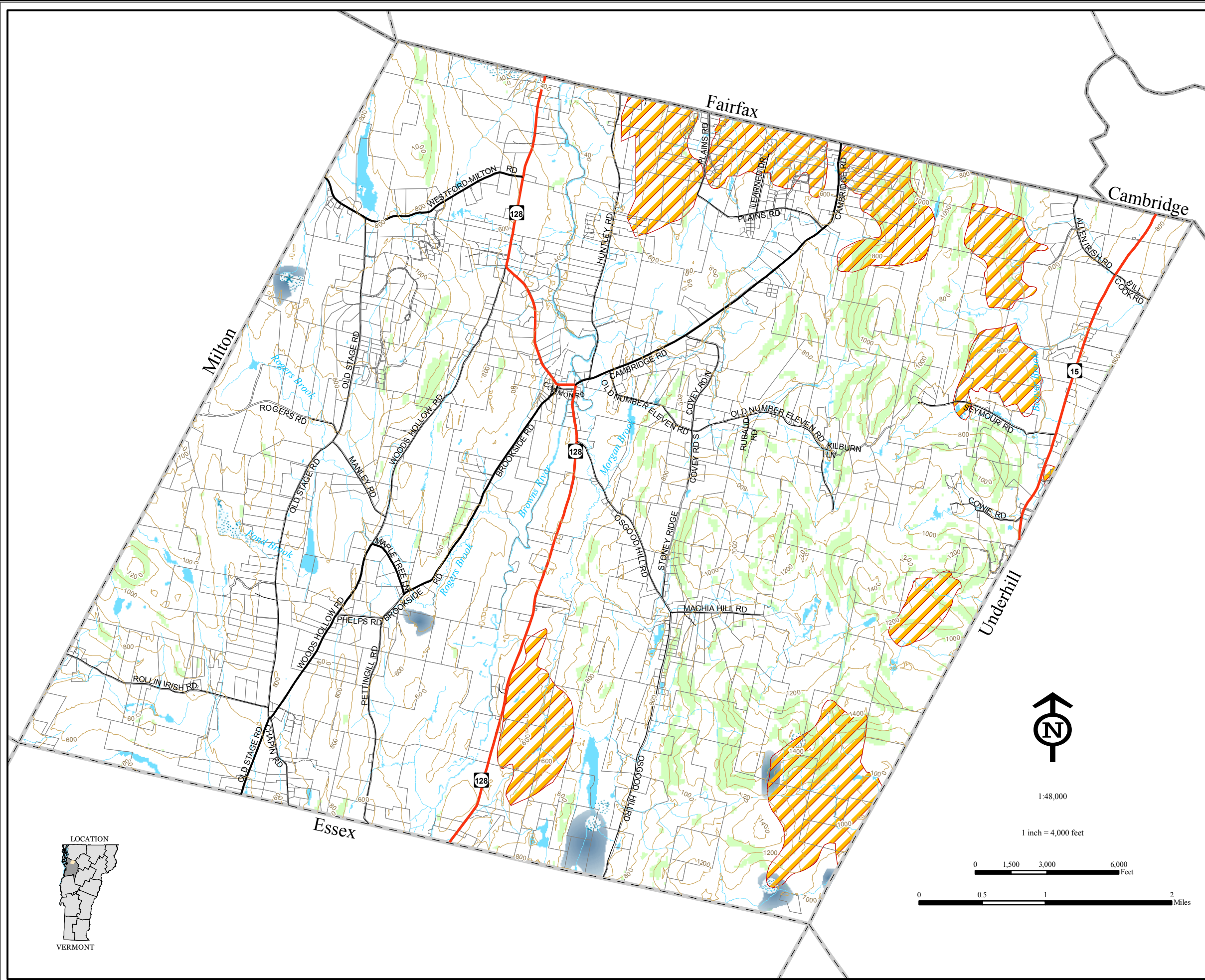
