

ROAD SCHEDULE

The Road Foreman and Board discussed a field access on Woods Hollow Road. The property owner would like to build a pole barn and would use the access for it. The location is not ideal; there is limited sight distance and it's near a curve. The Board would like the Zoning Administrator to inform the property owner that an access permit will be required due to the change of use.

A secondary access has been installed on Old Stage Road across from Penny Lane. The property owner will be notified that ditching in this area will occur this summer and if the owner would like to keep the access a culvert will be required.

The Brookside Cemetery Association would like the Town to dump fill on the low spot. The Board approved this as long as it is not located within the Water Resource Overlay District.

Glenn Rogers contact Bob Bancroft to discuss four wheel drive and recreational vehicles tearing up Rogers Road, which is a Class 4 road, as well as operators discarding empty cans. The Board would like to know what authority the Town has over closing and/or putting up a gate.

Bob Bancroft made a motion to approve the Road Schedule for June 12, 2009 through June 25, 2009, seconded by Dave Tilton. Motion passed: 2-0.

BILLS/CORRESPONDENCE

Bills were approved, correspondence was read.

FY'09 BUDGET

The Board reviewed status of the FY'09 budget. With 2 ½ weeks left of the fiscal year, there is \$94,566 in the budget. The Board would like the State Police and Sheriff's Department to cease patrolling for the remainder of this month.
