



### **CCMPO APPOINTMENT**

Bob Bancroft made a motion to appoint Suzanne Blanchard as representative and Gary Estus as alternate to the Chittenden County Metropolitan Organization, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

### **TRASH SERVICES**

Gauthier Trucking notified the Town of a resident who placed a significant amount of construction debris out over the last few weeks. A drive by was conducted to determine the amount. It was determined the amount of debris exceeded what is allowed as household garbage. A letter will be sent to the property owner advising the material is not considered household garbage and to contact a hauler to arrange for a dumpster.

The Board would like to consider entering into a multi year contract with Gauthier. Gauthier's will be contacted to see if they are interested, and if so, what the rate will be for a one, two and three year contract.

### **ROAD SCHEDULE**

Bob Bancroft made a motion to approve the Road Schedule for June 1, 2010 through June 12, 2010, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

The roads will be regraded and chloride applied. Gary noted that chloride works best when there is moisture in the road.

The Board would like to follow up on the installation of cameras at the town garage for surveillance. Due to her experience with property management, Suzanne Martin volunteered to review the information previously supplied to the Board and possibly offer other alternatives.

### **BILLS/CORRESPONDENCE**

Bills were approved and correspondence was read.

The Treasurer asked the Board if they want to bill the school for the vote on May 18, 2010. The cost absorbed by the Town was \$1,140, which includes payroll, ballots and postage. Bob Bancroft made a motion to send a bill to the Westford School Board in the amount of \$1,140 for election expenses, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

The Board received a response from the Town of Milton regarding the proposed development on the Bove property. They would like the Planning Coordinator to draft a response.

### **PERMIT REQUESTS FOR SCHULTZ & GOODRICH TRAILS**

Tim and Della Budell have submitted a request to perform maintenance work on the Schultz Trail and Goodrich Trail. The Schultz Trail proposal involves existing carpeting being used to smother goutweed. The proposal for the Goodrich Trail involves maintenance of an existing water bar. A site visit to both trails was conducted on April 20, 2010.

Tim and Della Budell were not present.

Eric and Suzanne Martin spoke against the carpeting on the Schultz Trail. They feel the carpet is dangerous and does not belong on the trail; carpet moves and can fold creating a tripping hazard. They would prefer to see other material, such as paper with gravel, used instead of carpet. Suzanne stated that she doesn't feel safe riding on the trail.

John advised that he has received other verbal complaints regarding the safety of the trail. Bob added he has received one verbal complaint.

#### **MINUTES**

Bob Bancroft made a motion to approve the May 13, minutes for the Special Selectboard meeting as written, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

Bob Bancroft made a motion to approve the May 13, minutes for the Town Plan public hearing as written, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

Bob Bancroft made a motion to approve the May 13, 2010 minutes for the regular meeting as amended, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

#### **DELIBERATIVE SESSION**

Bob Bancroft made a motion to enter Deliberative Session at 8:45 p.m. to discuss Tim and Della Budell's permit requests for the Schultz and Goodrich Trails, seconded by John Quinn. The Board exited Deliberative Session at 8:53 p.m.

Bob Bancroft made a motion to deny Tim and Della Budell's permit request for the Schultz Trail based on Section 6(c) of the Trails Ordinance. The denial letter, pending approval from the Town's attorney, will instruct the Budells to remove the carpeting with ten days of the date of the letter or the Town will remove at their expense. Seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

Bob Bancroft made a motion to approve Tim and Della Budell's permit request to maintain an existing water bar on the Goodrich Trail. The Road Foreman must be contacted a minimum of two business days prior to performing the maintenance, as well as after the work is completed to arrange for a post inspection. Seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

#### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Bob Bancroft made a motion to enter Executive Session at 8:57 p.m. to discuss personnel, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0. People in attendance were John Quinn, Bob and Nanette Rogers. The Board exited Executive Session at 8:59 p.m.

Bob Bancroft made a motion to appoint Matt Wamsganz until March 2012, and Casey Mathieu until March 2011 to the Development Review Board, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.

#### **ADJOURN**

Bob Bancroft made a motion to adjourn, seconded by John Quinn. Motion passed: 2-0.
