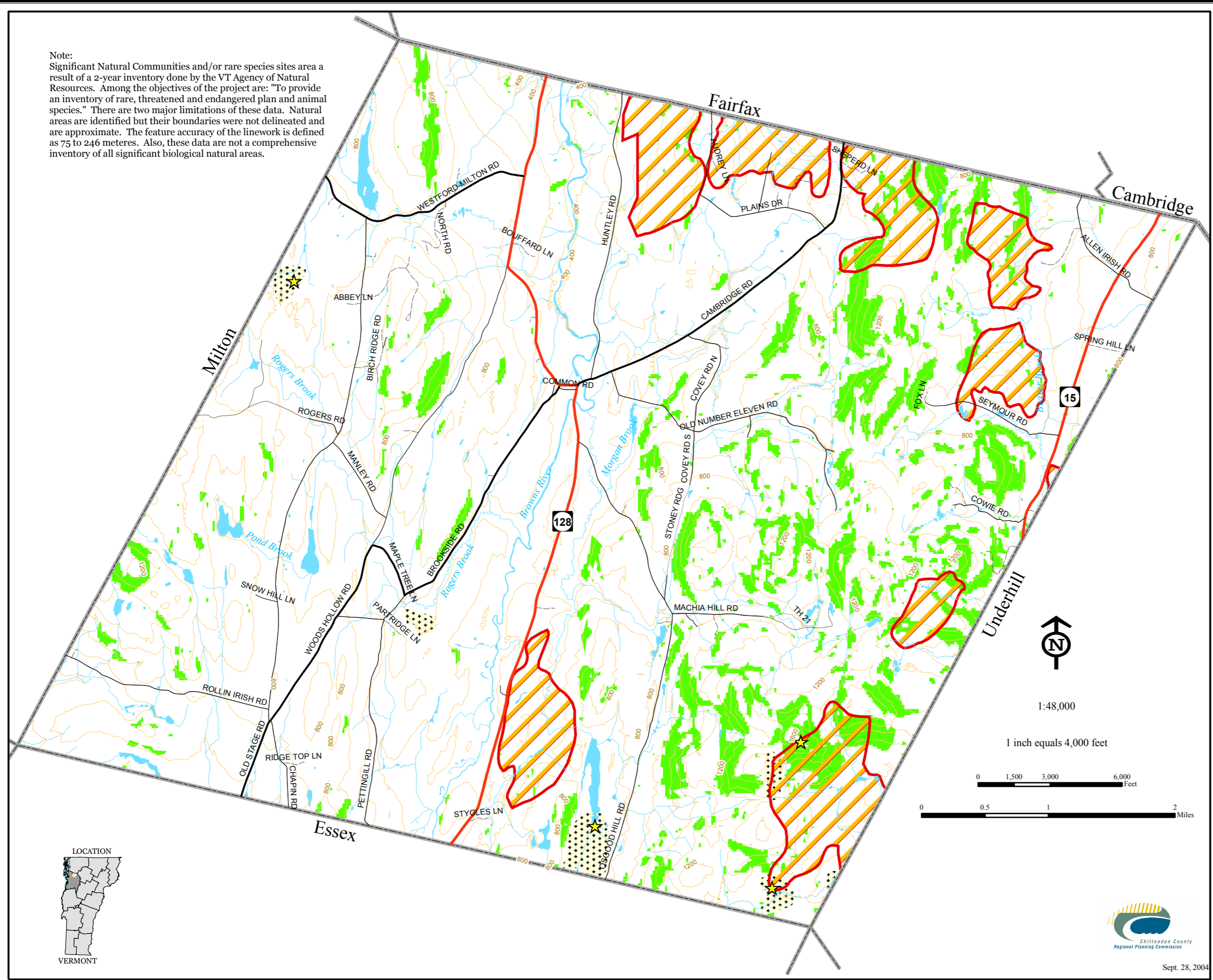


Map 3 Natural Features Westford Vermont Legend

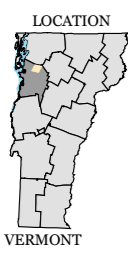
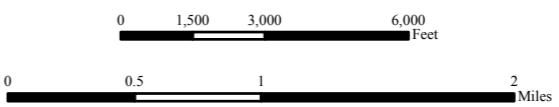
Note:
Significant Natural Communities and/or rare species sites area a result of a 2-year inventory done by the VT Agency of Natural Resources. Among the objectives of the project are: "To provide an inventory of rare, threatened and endangered plant and animal species." There are two major limitations of these data. Natural areas are identified but their boundaries were not delineated and are approximate. The feature accuracy of the linework is defined as 75 to 246 meters. Also, these data are not a comprehensive inventory of all significant biological natural areas.
